- 1 The Sanctuary shall accept presenting equines that have been abused or neglected, provided that the owners are willing to relinquish ownership of this animal to the Horse and Pony Protection Association of Newfoundland and Labrador (HAPPA-NL).
- 2 The Sanctuary shall accept an equine that is unwanted by its owner, provided that the Sanctuary Management Committee is satisfied that the owner is unable or unwilling to find alternative acceptable placement for the animal where it will be safe and treated humanely, and provided that the owner is willing to relinquish ownership to the Horse and Pony Protection Association of Newfoundland and Labrador (HAPPA-NL).
- 3 The Sanctuary will accept equines seized from their owners by an organization with the authority to do so, and will care for the animals on the same basis as other animals in its care, provided that organization remains responsible for the animal and covers the cost of its care for the duration of the time the animal is resident on the Sanctuary.
- 4 The Sanctuary will not accept an animal owned by an individual or another organization. Ownership must be unconditionally transferred to the Horse and Pony Protection Association of Newfoundland and Labrador (HAPPA-NL) before the animal is transferred to the Sanctuary.
- 5 A stallion will only be accepted on the Sanctuary if segregated facilities are available. A stallion may be accepted if it can be placed in alternate accommodation or in foster care.
- 6 The representative signing on behalf of HAPPA-NL must be an executive board member or duly authorized representative. Acceptance on behalf of HAPPA-NL is exercised by the Sanctuary Management Committee and that committee shall seek the recommendation of a veterinarian on the appropriateness of a transfer of ownership or adoption by HAPPA-NL.
- 7 An incoming animal must be segregated until such time that the Sanctuary Management Committee and/or a veterinarian is assured it is not carrying communicable diseases.
- 8 All necessary physical and psychological health care appropriate to equines will be provided by HAPPA-NL.

NOTES (EXTRACT FROM HAPPA-NL SANCTUARY POLICIES):

- 1 The Sanctuary provides a safe haven for equines that have been abused or neglected or are unwanted by their former owners. HAPPA-NL, the operator of the Sanctuary, is not a business. It does not buy or sell animals. It is a charity which accepts donations for which tax deductible receipts are provided.
- 2 Adoption of Animals
 - HAPPA-NL will endeavor to find a new owner and home for any equine in its care which is healthy. The animal will remain on the Sanctuary if an acceptable new owner cannot be found.
 - The determination that the animal is ready for a new owner and home will be made by the Sanctuary Management Committee, upon advised from a veterinarian that this is the case.
 - The Sanctuary Management Committee shall only place an animal with the new owner in a home after it (or a designate) has inspected the new home, discussed the care of the animal with the new owner, and is satisfied that the animal will receive good care in the new home.
 - Transfer of ownership may be preceded by a period of foster care with the respective new owner at the discretion and mutual agreement of both the Sanctuary Management Committee and the new owner.
